

DANGER—POISON—PRECAUTIONS

READ LABEL BEFORE USING



POISONOUS IF SWALLOWED

This product can kill you if swallowed even in small amounts: spray mist or dust may be fatal if swallowed.



POISONOUS BY SKIN CONTACT

Poisonous if touched by hands or spilled or splashed on skin, in eyes or on clothing (liquid goes through clothes.)



POISONOUS IF BREATHED

Breathing vapors, spray mist or dust may be fatal.

POISONOUS TO FISH AND WILDLIFE

This product is toxic to fish and wildlife. Birds and other wildlife in treated areas may be killed. Keep out of any body of water. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from treated area. Do not apply when runoff is likely to occur.

POISON SIGNS (Symptoms)

Parathion is a very dangerous poison. It rapidly enters the body on contact with all skin surfaces and eyes. Clothing wet with this material must be removed immediately. Exposed persons must receive prompt medical treatment or they may die.

Some of the signs and symptoms of poisoning are: Headache, nausea, vomiting, cramps, weakness, blurred vision, pinpoint pupils, tightness in chest, labored breathing, nervousness, sweating, watering of eyes, drooling or frothing of mouth and nose, muscle spasms and coma.

FIRST AID TREATMENT

Call a doctor (physician), clinic or hospital immediately. Explain that the victim has been exposed to parathion and describe his condition.

If breathing has stopped, start artificial respiration immediately and maintain until doctor sees victim.

If swallowed and victim is awake (conscious) make him vomit quickly. Induce vomiting by sticking finger down throat or by giving soapy or strong salty water to drink. Repeat until vomit is clear. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Have victim lie down and keep quiet. See doctor immediately.

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes while removing contaminated clothing and shoes. See doctor immediately.

CROP USE DIRECTIONS

FASCO THIODAN® PARATHION DUST 3-1 is a specially formulated insecticidal dust containing 3% Thiodan and 1% Parathion. It is designed for use against certain insects attacking tobacco as directed below.

DIRECTIONS

Use contrary to these directions may cause serious plant, crop or personal injury, excessive residues, unsatisfactory control or other unintended consequences.

TOBACCO — Against *Homworms, Budworms, Grasshoppers, Flea beetles, Aphids, Cuckies, Cabbage rooters, and Spotted wing.* Make application at the rate of 15 to 25 pounds per acre (amount depending on the size of the plants) under calm conditions with a dusting machine that will give thorough coverage of all plant surfaces. Repeat applications as necessary. Do not use within 5 days of priming or 15 days of cutting. Avoid plant juices coming in contact with skin or other parts of the body of those engaged in cutting crop.

NOTE — Crops having residues in excess of their permitted tolerances should not be marketed and to do so may violate State Law and will violate Federal law when sold in interstate commerce. Such crops should not be marketed without removal of such excess residues.

WARNING

Poisonous if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Rapidly absorbed through skin. Repeated inhalation or skin contact may, without symptoms, progressively increase susceptibility to parathion poisoning. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing.

Wear natural rubber gloves, goggles and clean water-proof or freshly laundered protective clothing (coveralls, cap, etc.) Destroy and replace gloves frequently. Wash thoroughly with soap and warm water before eating or smoking. Bathe immediately after work and change all clothing. Wash clothing thoroughly with soap and hot water before re-use. In case of contact, immediately remove contaminated clothing and wash skin thoroughly with soap and water. Do not breathe dust or vapor. Wear a mask or respirator of a type passed by the U. S. Bureau of Mines for parathion protection. Airplane pilots should wear full-face canister-type mask. If handled indoors provide mechanical exhaust ventilation.

Keep all unprotected persons out of the area or vicinity where there may be danger of drift. Vacated areas should not be re-entered until drifting insecticides and volatile residues have dissipated. Do not contaminate feed or foodstuffs. Wash hands, arms and face thoroughly with soap and water before eating and smoking.

USE ONLY WHEN WEARING THE FOLLOWING PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT AND CLOTHING

- (1) Wear water-proof pants, coat, hat, rubber boots or rubber overshoes.
- (2) Wear safety goggles.
- (3) Wear mask or respirator approved by the U.S. Bureau of Mines for parathion protection.
- (4) Wear heavy duty, natural rubber gloves.

WORK SAFETY RULES

Keep all unprotected persons and children away from treated area or where there is danger of drift.

Do not rub eyes or mouth with hands. If you feel sick in any way, STOP work and get help right away. Call a doctor (physician), clinic or hospital — immediately. Explain that the victim has been exposed to parathion and describe his condition. After first aid is given (see First Aid Treatment Section) and if a doctor cannot come, take victim to clinic or hospital.

IMPORTANT! Before removing gloves, wash them with soap and water. Always wash hands, face and arms with soap and water before smoking, eating or drinking.

AFTER WORK, take off all work clothes and shoes. Shower, using soap and water. Wear only clean clothes when leaving job. Do not wear contaminated clothing. Wash protective clothing and protective equipment with soap and water after each use. Respirator should be cleaned and filter replaced according to instructions included with respirator.
