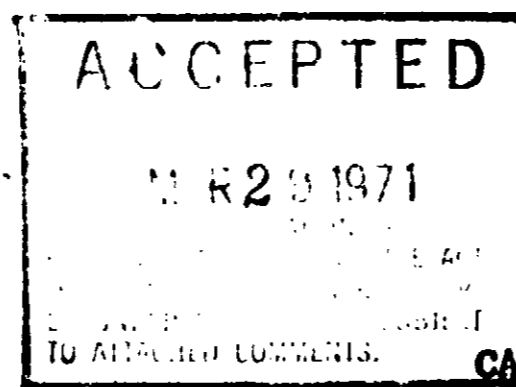

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

IMPORTANT: Read these entire Directions and Conditions of Sale Before Using Fasco Cattle "Butt" Bag-5.

LOUSE AND HORN FLY CONTROL: Suspend Fasco Cattle "Butt" Bag-5 in areas frequented by cattle or in gateways or lanes through which the animals pass daily for water, feed or mineral. Bags may also be suspended in loafing sheds or in front of protected mineral feeders. For lactating dairy cows, bags may be suspended in the exit through which the cows leave the milking barn. In all cases, the bags should be adjusted so that the bottom of the bag will hang four to six inches below the topline of the cattle.

AN AID IN REDUCING FACE FLY POPULATIONS: Suspend FASCO CATTLE "BUTT" BAG-5 in the same manner as described under "Horn Fly Control" except as follows: (1) The bottom of the bags should be about 24 inches from the ground to insure that the faces of the cattle will be dusted. (2) The bags must be located so that animals will be forced to use them daily.

INSTALLATION OF FASCO CATTLE "BUTT" BAG-5: Suspend the bags by inserting rope, chain, or wire through the grommets at the top of the bag and attaching to an overhead structure or by hooking the grommets into hooks fixed to a stationary overhead 2 x 4 at the heights recommended for horn fly or face fly control. In areas of frequent or heavy rainfall, bags should be protected from the weather. Install as many 10-pound Cattle "Butt" Bag-5 as necessary in lanes or other openings to assure proper dusting of the animals. When dust bags are provided on a free-choice basis, allow one 10-pound bag per 10 to 20 animals. After the bags are in place, pull the rip cord to allow the insecticide to fall into the bottom of the bag.

RESTRICTIONS:

Do not hang Fasco Cattle "Butt" Bag-5 over feed, mineral or water troughs.

CAUTION:

Do not contaminate food or feed. Keep out of the reach of children. If poisoning occurs obtain prompt medical aid. Prolonged exposure will result in cholinesterase depression.

PHYSICIANS NOTE: Atropine sulfate is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.
