FASCO COPPER SULPHUR DUST 3.4-75 a fungicide dust containing Copper and Sulphur for use on peanuts as described below.

DIRECTIONS

PEANUTS — Against Leafspot apply 20 lbs. per acre when disease first appears. Repeat at 7 to 10 day intervals as needed. Do not exceed 30 Ibs. per acre. May be applied up to day of harvest.

If this product is used in accordance with label directions, the above crop may be grazed or harvested for use as feed for dairy and meat animals without resulting in residues in milk or meat.

NOTE — The U.S. Food and Drug Administration has set tolerances for pesticide residues. 
