Zineb Fungicide is designed for use as a spray against certain foliage diseases of plants.

Use contrary to these directions may cause plant, crop or personal injury, unsatisfactory control or other unintended consequences.

AZALEA PETAL BLIGHT: Begin applications when flowers are in bud. Spray at least three times each week during bloom period. Use a fine mist spray to avoid damage and discoloration of bloom. Spray ground under bushes thoroughly. Mix with water at the rate of 5 teaspoons per gal., 1 cup per 10 gal, or 8 oz. per 25 gal.

VEGETABLES: Against Early and Late Blight, Grey Leafspot and Anthracnose of tomatoes, apply when first fruit clusters are well formed or when disease threatens. Repeat every 3 to 10 days as needed. Do not apply within 5 days of harvest. Against Downy Mildew and Anthracnose of cucumbers, cantaloupes, melons and squash, begin applications when plants emerge or when disease first appears. Repeat every 3 to 10 days as needed. Do not apply within 5 days of harvest. Mix with water and apply at the same rate given for Azalea Petal Blight above.


