COTTON: For the control of boll weevil, cotton aphid, leafhopper, white flies, brown cotton leafworm, cotton leaf perforator, thrips, leafworm and lygus bug—mix 1 to 2 quarts with sufficient water for good coverage per acre.

TOMATOES: For the control of spider mites, aphids, and tomato russet mite apply 1½ pints per acre with sufficient water for good coverage. Do not apply within 3 days of harvest.

COTTON: For the control of boll weevil, cotton aphid, leafhopper, white flies, brown cotton leafworm, cotton leaf perforator, thrips, leafworm and lygus bug—mix 1 to 2 quarts with sufficient water for good coverage per acre.

TOMATOES: For the control of spider mites, aphids, and tomato russet mite apply 1½ pints per acre with sufficient water for good coverage. Do not apply within 3 days of harvest.

CABBAGE, BROCCOLI, KALE, AND MUSTARD: For control of aphids, imported cabbage worm, and cabbage looper apply 1 to 2 pints with sufficient water for full coverage per acre. Repeat as necessary. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest.

POTATOES: For control of aphids and leafhopper apply a spray of 4.8 pints with sufficient water for good coverage per acre. Repeat as necessary. Do not apply within 3 days of harvest.

BEANS: To control Mexican bean beetle make two or more applications, as needed, of a spray containing 2½ pints with sufficient water for good coverage per acre. Do not apply within 2 days of harvest.
