KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN (12 Point Type)

Chlordane is toxic to humans and warm blood animals. If in contact with skin, wash thoroughly with soap and water. If swallowed, give tablespoonful of baking soda or mustard in glass of warm water and repeat until vomit is clear. Care should be taken not to use on forage crops to be used as feed for dairy cattle or to animals being finished for slaughter. Avoid inhalation. Avoid contamination of foodstuffs and feed.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

LAWN AND TURF: To control ants, fire ants, harvester ants and leaf cutting ants, apply at the rate of 30 lbs. per acre. Birds feeding on treated area may be killed.

To control Japanese beetle larvae, Asiatic beetle larvae, European chafer larvae, June beetle larvae, white fringed beetle larvae and white grubs, apply at the rate of 50-100 lbs. per acre (5 lbs. per 2,000 sq. ft.) To obtain a minimum of 5 years control, apply 100-200 lbs. per acre. Keep children and pets off the treated area until the area has been well watered and dried completely.

VEGETABLES: To control cabbage maggots under newly set cabbage, broccoli, brussels sprouts, cauliflower, collards, kale and kohlrabi, dust around base of plants as soon as set in the field. Wash the treatment into the soil. One or two repeated applications are frequently necessary.

To control wireworms in celery, peppers, potatoes and sweet potatoes, apply 50-100 lbs. per acre. Work into the top 3-4 inches of the soil prior to or at planting.

STRAWBERRIES: To control strawberry root worm, apply 100-200 lbs. per acre as a preplant soil treatment. To control strawberry root weevil and white grubs, apply 200 lbs. per acre and work into the soil as soon as the plants are set.

PRECAUTIONS IN USING (18 Point type)

TOXIC TO FISH AND WILDLIFE. KEEP OUT OF LAKES, PONDS, AND STREAMS. DO NOT APPLY IN ANY MANNER NOT SPECIFIED ON THE LABEL.

Rinse equipment and containers and dispose of wastes by burying in non-crop lands away from water supplies. Containers should be disposed by punching holes in them and burying with wastes, or by burning. (KEEP OUT OF SMOKE).
