



DIRECTIONS FOR USE

WBetaAI is well suited for concentrating solar power systems. The intermediate WBetaAI has a melting point of 100°C, which is higher than the melting point of the paraffin used in the paraffin-based system. A pre- and timing application of 100 lbs/acre Copper Sulfate at 1/2 rate recommended for applications inhibits the growth of immature buds. The recommendations of your State Agricultural Experiment Station or State Agriculture Extension Service should be followed.

1. Prepare a 1:1000 spray solution

(1) Determine number of acres to be treated and select gallons of TUMBLEweed Defoliant Concentrate per acre to be applied. Multiply total land area to be TUMBLEweed Cotton Defoliant Concentrate to be applied to this acreage.

c) Select spray solution application rate in gallons per acre and multiply by number of acres to be treated to obtain gallons of spray solution required.

(d) Run sufficient water equal to about $\frac{1}{4}$ of the gallonsage of spray which is to be prepared into the batch tank. Add required gallons of TUMBLEAF Cotton Defoliant Concentrate and agitate until thoroughly mixed. Then add sufficient additional water to bring the volume to the required amount, and add to the TUMBLEAF Cotton Defoliant Concentrate mix. It is desired due to the batch tank as raw water is being added.

Ground application: Use high clearance spray equipment with at least five nozzle tips. Low pressure overhead nozzle and adjust the pressure to maintain a spray volume of 10 to 15 gallons per acre.

Aerial application: Maintain a spray volume of 10 to 15 gallons per acre. To reduce drift, spray at the ground fly height to the crop and should not apply during periods of thermal inversions.
Accurate uniform placement of the spray solution is essential for effective defoliation.

Cleaning Spray Equipment: Equipment used to apply other types of defoliants (including areas of contamination inside and outside the fuselages of spray planes) must be cleaned to remove all residues before TUMBLEAF Cotton Defoliant Concentrate is used. Failure to follow these directions may result in fire or other damage to the equipment. Equipment must also be cleaned after using TUMBLEAF Cotton Defoliant Concentrate.
