- 3) Based on toxicity ranking per the acute toxicity review, the First Aid statements should be placed on the label in the following order and placed in a box:

"IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:...
IF IN EYES:...
IF SWALLOWED:..."

- 4) Per the toxicity review, the following text appearing in precautionary statements Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals: "Harmful if swallowed. Causes irritation of eyes, skin, nose, throat and digestive tract" must be revised to read "Harmful if absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing", as the product belongs to toxic category III for acute dermal and primary dermal irritation and toxic category IV for acute oral, inhalation and primary eye irritation.
