STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Pesticide Storage

If storing this product below freezing, user should shake or roll the container to ensure proper product consistency. Keep out of reach of children and animals. Store in original containers only. Store in a cool, dry place and avoid excess heat. Store at or below room temperature. Carefully open containers. After partial use, replace lid of container and close tightly or if in a bag or pouch, fold over and secure the bag or pouch closure. Do not put product into food or drink containers. Nonrefillable Plastic Containers: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container ¼ full with water and recap. Shake for 10 seconds. Pour rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Repeat this procedure two more times. Then offer for reconditioning if appropriate or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by incineration or if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke. Do not burn, unless allowed by state and local ordinances.
