**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS (AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS)
CAUTION**

Do not use on humans. Avoid contact with concentrate. Avoid inhalation of spray mist. Avoid contact with skin or eyes. Vapor or spray may be absorbed through the skin. Applicators must wear the following protective clothing during the treatment process: elbow-length, waterproof gloves; a waterproof apron; and unlined, waterproof boots. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Wash hands thoroughly after using and before eating or smoking. Children should not be allowed to handle or apply this product.

Do not use on cats. Do not apply to nursing mothers or on puppies under three months of age. Do not use on sick or convalescing animals. Harmful if swallowed. Use only as directed on the label. Use of this product is permitted only for treatment of mites. Improper dilution of this product could cause serious injury to your pet. The use of this product for treatment of other pests is prohibited.

This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Keep out of lakes, streams or ponds. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SARCOPTIC MANGE - Mix GAMMA R-X according to dilution table, and repeat application at weekly intervals for two or more treatments as necessary.

Water animals prior to being dipped to avoid animal's drinking of the emulsion. Discard the emulsion when it becomes too fouled for use, or depleted of active ingredient.

SPRAYING OR DIPPING: Always use the strength recommended on dilution table. Add GAMMA R-X directly to cool water to obtain the proper dilution, wt./wt. Complete and thorough coverage of the animal is essential.

MIXING - GAMMA R-X mixes easily with cool water, hard or soft. Only slight agitation is required to assure complete suspension of active ingredients. When mixed according to dilution table, GAMMA R-X WILL NOT CLOG A SPRAYER.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
