Dear Mr. Alford:

Regarding registration for chemicals on a "no-residue, zero-tolerance" basis which expires January 1, 1969.

Pages 472 and 473 in the U.S.D.A. Summary of Registered Agricultural Pesticides Chemical Uses list the Lindane tolerances for use on beef cattle, swine and sheep which I believe satisfy the finite tolerance requirements. Information now supplied to me indicates this isn't necessarily true.

Attached is label copy of our Lindane product which was revised and reapproved June 13, 1967. Please comment on the legality of its use after January 1, 1969.

$\frac{1}{8}$ oz.  APPROXIMATE MEASURE 8 FL. OUNCES

$\frac{2}{8}$ oz. DIP OR SPRAY FOR SWINE, SHEEP AND CATTLE
DIRECTIONS FOR SPRAY OR DIP:

$\frac{3}{8}$ oz. For Sarcoptic Mange, Lice, Fleas or Ticks on Swine, Sheep and Beef Cattle—
Mix 8 ounces in 12 1/2 to 20 gallons of water; or 1 ounce in 1 1/2 to 2 1/2 gallons of water; or 1 tablespoonful in 1 gallon of water. Cover animals thoroughly including inside of ears. Spray the premises and animals to control fleas. Do not treat animals under three months of age. Use the higher dilution for treating young animals. Do not treat sows within two weeks of farrowing nor for at least three weeks thereafter. Avoid treating animals in cold, stormy weather. Avoid treating overheated or sick animals. Do not treat animals later than 60 days before slaughter for human consumption.

$\frac{4}{8}$ oz. **WARNING:** Do not use on dairy animals, household pets or humans. Do not reuse container. Destroy when empty.

$\frac{5}{8}$ oz. **WARNING:** Harmful if swallowed. Avoid prolonged contact. Vapor or spray may be absorbed through the skin. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water. If taken internally, use emetic of mustard. Call physician immediately. Avoid contamination of feed or foodstuffs.

$\frac{6}{8}$ oz. **WARNING:** This product is toxic to fish and wildlife. Keep out of lakes, streams, and ponds. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

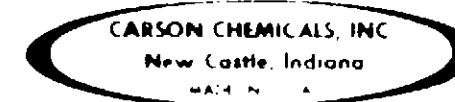

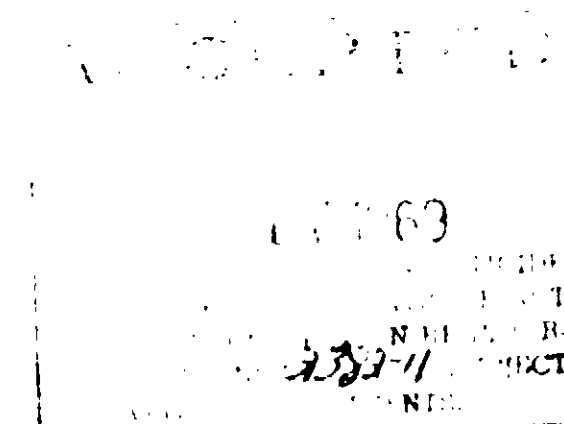
