Cover animals thoroughly including inside of ears. Use the higher dilution for treating young animals.

Discard the emulsion when it becomes too fouled for use or depleted of active ingredient.

DISPOSAL OF DIP

Used dip solutions must be disposed of in accordance with the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA). If the applicator generates more than 1000 kg of used dip solution per month or more than 1000 kg used dip solution in combination with other hazardous waste, the material must be treated as a hazardous waste subject to subpart C of RCRA.
