GENERAL INFORMATION

Snails and slugs generally feed at night. They are most active in cool, moist places such as under leaves, stones, and in the soil. They are attracted to plants such as strawberries, lettuce, and other leafy vegetables.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Hopkins Snail and Slug Pellets are used to control snails and slugs on lawns, lawns, and gardens. Scatter pellets directly on the plants to be protected. Do not use on strawberry beds within 100 feet of the plants.

Though pellets are not toxic to humans, they are highly attractive to children. Be especially careful when using pellets in areas where children play.
