**DIRECTIONS:** Dust liberally over animal and rub thoroughly into skin. Be sure to include the ears, legs, feet and between the toes. Comb out dead ticks a few hours after treatment. Repeat application at one to three week intervals if necessary. To control ticks or fleas around animal quarters, remove debris and use at the rate of 4 ounces per 25 sq. ft.
