It is the Agency's view that terms, such as "natural" are misleading health and safety claims and therefore constitute misbranding under section 2(Q)(1)(A) of FIFRA. Therefore, the use of "natural" and other similar claims is not permitted for any product registered under FIFRA.

Therefore, you must remove the following claims from your product labeling;

- Natural Flea & tick Shampoo for dogs.
- Natural Flea & tick shampoo for cats.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed. Submit three copies of revised the final printed labeling prior to releasing product for shipment.
