

## CONCENTRATED SOLUTION

A Concentrated Lime and Sulphur Solution for Official Dipping To Control Psoroptic and Sarcoptic Mange.

Active ingredients:
Calcium Polysulphide
Calcium Thiosulfate
Inert Ingredients
For the displace of Control Character Hope was the fallowing dilution.

For the dipping of Cattle, Sheep and Hogs use the following dilutions:

Cattle . . . 1 gallon to 15 gallons of water. Sheep and Hogs . . . 1 galion to  $20\frac{1}{2}$  gallons of water.

Redipping . . . is necessary in 12 to 14 days.

Repeat . . . as often as necessary.

The temperature of the baths should be 100-105 degrees F. The bath should be changed and the vat cleaned when it becomes dirty.

The solution should not be used for a second dipping but should be made fresh.

Do not dip sick or debilitated animals. Do not dip in cold or stormy weather. For hand dressing a 1 to 8 solution should be used.

CAUTION: Use rubber gloves for hand dressing. Avoid contact with skin or eyes. May cause skin irritation. In case of contact, wash thoroughly with plenty of water.
