The proposed amendment to the registration of the product cited above under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act removing the active ingredient, MGK R-11, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

- 1.) This change in formulation must be a change in the basic formulation and is being accepted under that condition. Submit a revised Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) with the proper block checked.
- 2.) The density of the product is listed as 7.19 on the CSF but as 7.26 in the chemistry data. Explain.
- 3.) Submit a 1 year storage stability study. The formulated product must be analyzed for its active ingredients at time zero and during a year in storage. The storage must be under warehouse conditions of temperature and humidity using containers similar to those that will be used in the trade. This data must be submitted within 15 months of the date of this letter.
