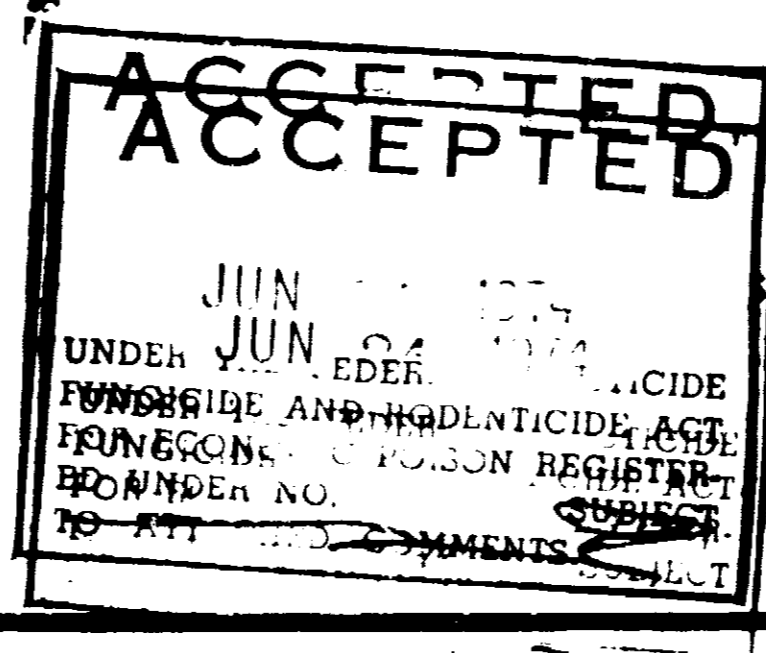
DIRECTIONS: From a distance of 2 to 5 inches, spray a 2 or 3 second burst through teeth of clipper blades between each use and especially before storing. When sanitizing effect is desired, make certain blades are thoroughly wet with spray.
