DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labelling.

Spray until the dog's coat is slightly damp. On heavily coated dogs, ruffle haircoat and spray against the lay of the hair. Do not spray into dog's face. Instead, moisten cloth and wipe face, avoiding eyes and nose. Spray/wet ticks thoroughly. Repeat treatment as necessary, but not more than once weekly. Spray may discolor the coat of white-haired dogs in the presence of oxidising agents such as whitener shampoos and bleaching agents.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS - HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: May be harmful if swallowed, avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Wash thoroughly after handling.

Do not use on pups under 3 months of age nor on pregnant bitches. Do not soak dog or use more frequently than once weekly. Carbaryl is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Do not use this product on dogs within a few days before or after treatment with, or exposure to, other cholinesterase-inhibiting drugs, pesticides or chemicals. Atropine is antidotal. At first sign of adverse reaction, shampoo dog thoroughly with a non-pesticidal shampoo and consult a veterinarian if signs persist.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT:

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or poison control center. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching finger to back of the throat or, if available, by administering syrup of ipecac. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF ON SKIN: Wash off with soap and water.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS: FLAMMABLE! Keep away from heat and open flame.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL DIRECTIONS

STORAGE: FLAMMABLE. Keep away from heat and open flame.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash.
