PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS (AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS)
CAUTION
 Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Avoid skin contact. Avoid inhalation. Avoid contamination of feedstuffs. Wash hands after applying. Do not treat kittens and puppies under 4 weeks of age. Some cats may be sensitive to PARID-X Spray with Carbaryl. Do not exceed recommended dose. Do not spray directly on kittens or puppies. Carbaryl is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Do not use this product on an animal simultaneously or within a few days before or after treatment with or exposure to cholinesterase inhibiting drugs, pesticides, or chemicals. Atropine is antidotal. Consult veterinarian at first sign of adverse reaction.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT
 If Swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink at least 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching fingers to back of throat or, if available, by administering syrup of ipecac. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
 If In Eyes: Flush with steady stream of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.
 If On Skin: Wash off with soap and water.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS
 This product is toxic to aquatic organisms. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS
FLAMMABLE Keep away from heat or open flame.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL DIRECTIONS
STORAGE Flammable. Keep away from heat or open flame.
DISPOSAL Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Do not reuse empty container. Rinse container thoroughly, securely wrap in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

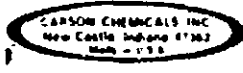

DIRECTIONS FOR USE
 It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
 Remove nozzle cap from trigger sprayer by rotating tab to up position and pressing away from nozzle. Retain nozzle cap and re-apply between uses. Spray at a distance of 8 to 12 inches by squeezing trigger repeatedly and rapidly.

FOR KITTENS AND PUPPIES (over 4 weeks old)
 Wrap the animal in a towel which has been sprayed lightly. Leave the nose and mouth exposed for normal breathing. Keep the animal wrapped for 5 to 10 minutes. Fleas may then be removed from the coat by picking or combing. Repeat as necessary but not more often than once weekly.

FOR DOGS AND CATS
 Direct the spray over the animal until the entire coat is slightly damp. Do not spray directly into face. On a heavily coated animal, ruffle the coat and spray against the lay of the hair. For best results in controlling ticks, spray directly on the tick. Thoroughly spray interior of kennel or other sleeping quarters. Repeat treatment as necessary but not more often than once weekly. This spray may discolor the coat of white haired animals in the presence of oxidizing agents. Whitener, shampoos and bleaching agents are oxidizing agents. Do not treat rugs, carpets, drapes and other fabrics. Avoid application to structural surfaces where visible spray residue is objectionable.

FOR HORSES AND PONIES
 Remove excess dirt and dust by brushing coat. Apply spray directly to horse's coat giving particular attention to legs, shoulders, flanks, neck, and topline. To treat face, dampen a cloth with spray and rub on face and head being careful to avoid eyes. Repeat as necessary. Not to be used on animals intended for slaughter.
