HAZARDS TO HUMANS (AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS)
CAUTION**

DO NOT USE ON CATS.

DO NOT GET IN EYES. In case of eye contact, flush eyes with plenty of water. Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Avoid skin contact. Avoid inhaling. Avoid contamination of food-stuffs. Wash hands after applying. Discard bottle when empty.

Free bitches from fleas before they bear pups. Do not use on dogs nursing puppies or on pups under 10 weeks old.

Note to Physician and Veterinarian: Chlorpyrifos is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine is an antidote by injection only.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If Swallowed: Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of the throat with finger. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get medical attention.

If On Skin: Remove contaminated clothing and wash with soap and water.

If In Eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Shake well before using. **CAUTION:** Product may squirt out of nozzle when nozzle cap is removed if at temperatures higher than room temperature. Remove nozzle cap from trigger spray by rotating tab to up position and pressing away from nozzle. Retain nozzle cap and re-apply between uses.

Place dog on a table or bench, preferably out of doors. Hold container in upright position 3 - 6 inches from the dog and thoroughly spray all over the body against the lay of the coat. Avoid spraying in eyes. Spray to leave the coat slightly damp down to skin level. Repeat treatment as necessary, but not more often than once every two weeks. Spray bedding and sleeping area.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL DIRECTIONS

STORAGE: Close nozzle between uses to avoid accidental loss of product. Protect from freezing.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
