For the control of Screw Worm infestations and Ear Tick control in cattle, sheep, goats and horses and Flooce Worms in sheep and goats.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE
It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Shake well before using. Use this spray sparingly. Surprisingly little will do the job. Hold dispenser upright and point valve in desired direction of spray. Spray is released by depressing plunger valve. For best results, hold valve 6 to 12 inches from area being sprayed.

FOR SCREW WORM CONTROL spray directly into and around infested wound until theroughly wet. Repeat treatment at 5 to 7 day intervals until healed.

FOR FLEECE WORMS and other secondary blow flies, shear infested five, thoroughly spray directly into as well as area surrounding infestation. Repeat when necessary.

FOR EAR TICK CONTROL grasp car firmly with one hand. Use other to release spray downward into animal's bar. A 3 securic application is recommended for large animals, 2 second for smaller animals. Penetrales masses of ear wax and rapidly kills Ear Tick largue and nymps. Protects against re-infestation for weeks or more.

TO PROTECT WOUNDS against acres: worms, fleece worms and other recondary blow flies, spray all superficial wounds, shear cuts, etc. and Sight Docking. Dehorning, or Castrating. Respect application in 3 days, then as necessary unfiltered is healed.
