

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Flotate nozzle counter clockwise 1/4 turn and squeeze trigger to initiate a fine mist spray. (Close nozzlę after use to avoid loss of product). Spray at a distance of 6 in 12 inches by squeezing trigger repeatedly and rapidly.

FOR DOGS AND CATS

Direct the soray over the animal until the entire coat is slightly damp. Do not spray directly into face. On a heavily coated animal, ruffle the coat and spray against the lay of the hair. For best results in controlling tricks, spray directly on the trick. Thoroughly spray into ior of kennel or other sleeping quarters. Repeat treatment at necessary. Do not spray structural surfaces where spotting, staining, or discoloration may be obsectionable.

FOR KITTENS AND PUPPIES

Treat same as dogs and cats: except for nursing kittens and puppies, wrap the ariimal in a tower which has been sprayed lightly. Leave the nose and mouth exposed for normal breathing. Keep the animal wrapped for 5 to 10 minutes. Fleas may then be removed from the coat hy picking or combing. Repeat as necessary.

FOR HORSES AND PONIES

To control Stable Fires, Horn Flies, Houseflies, Fare Flies, Horse Flies, Deer Flies, Bot Flies, Mosquitnes and Gnass, apply spray directly to horry's coat onlying particular attention to legs, shoulders, flanks, neck, and topline. To treat face, damp en a cloth with spray and rub on face and head being careful to avoid eyes. Reprait as necessary.
