#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product with its labeling.

**CAUTION:** Product may squirt out at temperatures higher than room temperature. To prevent this, rotate the trigger sprayer by rotating tab to up position. Do not use cap and re-apply between inches by squeezing trigger repeatedly.

##### FOR DOGS AND CATS

Direct the spray over the animal. Do not spray structural surfaces which may be objectionable. Coated animal, ruffle the coat and allow to dry before removing dead fleas. Results in controlling ticks, spray the interior of kennel or other sleeping quarters.

##### FOR KITTENS AND PUPPIES

Treat same as dogs and cats except animal in a towel which has been exposed for normal breathing. Keep fleas may then be removed from the necessary.

##### FOR ROLL ON APPLICATOR

Specially designed for use on cats and cap and invert bottle for application along the hair coat giving special attention to the base of the tail. Apply cautiously at delicate mucous membranes. (Do not apply more product than is necessary. Desired area of treatment is damp.)

##### FOR BIRD LICE

For control of bird lice on parakeets, bird in cage but remove food, water, and sprayer. Depress pump with index finger coating directly on bird, avoid damp. Repeat as necessary but not more than two times.

##### FOR CAGE MITES

For cage mite control, remove bird, thoroughly until all surfaces are damp, crannies. Clean cage with hot water, but not more often than two times.
