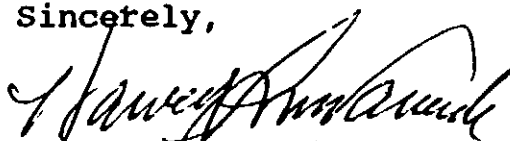

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT: In case of eye contact, immediately flush eyes with plenty of water.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL DIRECTIONS

STORAGE: Protect from freezing. If frozen, allow to warm to room temperature and shake well before using. Keep tightly sealed in original container.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Shake well before using.

FOR CATS, KITTENS, DOGS AND PUPPIES

To kill fleas, ticks and lice thoroughly mix 1/2 oz. (1 tablespoon) of Pyrethrin Dip with 1 gal. warm water. Do not dilute more dip than will be used in a 24 hr. period.

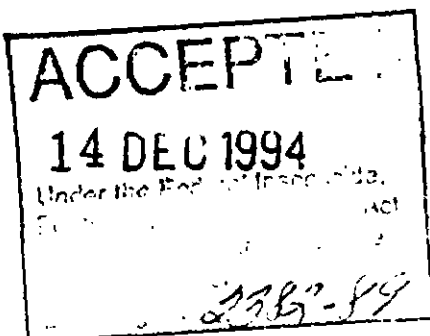
APPLICATION: Dip should be applied to dry or damp (not wet) coat. Sponge, dip or spray animal with diluted Pyrethrin Dip making sure all areas are soaked to the skin. Let animal drip dry. DO NOT RINSE OFF! Use Pyrethrin Dip as directed by your veterinarian and as often as necessary without interval restrictions on frequency of dipping.
