FIRST AID

- If Swallowed**
- Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING:

DILUTION: To kill fleas ticks and lice, thoroughly mix 1/2 oz (1 tablespoon) of dip with 1 gallon of warm water. For use under more severe reinfestation pressure, dilute at the rate of 1 fl. oz. (2 tablespoons) per gallon. Do not dilute more dip than will be used in a 24 hour period.

APPLICATION: Dip should be applied to dry or damp (not wet) coat. Sponge, dip or spray animal with the diluted concentrate making sure all areas are soaked to the skin. Let animal drip dry. Do not submerge the animals nose, mouth or eyes. **DO NOT RINSE OFF!** Do not reapply product for 7 days. Do not use on puppies or kittens under 12 weeks of age.

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.
