**DILUTION:** To kill fleas, ticks, and lice, thoroughly mix 1/2 oz (1 tablespoon) of dip with 1 gallon of warm water. For use under more severe reinfestation pressure, dilute at the rate of 1 fl. oz. (2 tablespoons) per gallon. Do not dilute more dip than will be used in a 24 hour period.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS: Dip should be applied to dry or damp (not wet) coat. Sponge, dip or spray animal with the diluted concentrate making sure all areas are soaked to the skin. Let animal drip dry. Do not submerge the animal's nose, mouth or eyes. DO NOT RINSE OFF! Do not reapply product for 7 days.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.
