Note that the phrase "if irritation persists" has been deleted from the "If On Skin" section. The statement "get medical attention" is required in case of dermal absorption of the material, although there may not be concurrent dermal irritation.

However, the "If Swallowed" statement is not required since the product formulation is category IV for this route of exposure.

d. On the Confidential Statement of Formula, covert the flashpoint from Celsius to Fahrenheit and revise the flammability statement on the label to the following:

Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

Kills fleas for 2 months and ticks for 1 month.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labelling. Spray in a well ventilated area. Wear rubber gloves when spraying.

Remove cap and insert spray pump. Hold container upright and spray the animal from a distance of 8-12 inches. Point nozzle toward animal and start spraying at the tail, moving the container rapidly and making sure the coat is thoroughly wetted down to the skin. Spray against the lay of the hair, ruffling the coat on long-haired dogs. Weight of dog, length of hair and density of coat will determine amount of spray to be applied to wet the skin. This 8 oz. bottle should be sufficient for three applications at one month intervals to an average 30-35 lbs. dog. Lighter applications will reduce period of effectiveness and require more frequent treatments. Avoid spraying in eyes or on genitalia. Allow dog to air dry or blow dry. Do not towel dry.
