HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

WARNING: Do not use on puppies or kittens under 12 weeks of age. Consult a veterinarian before treating debilitated, aged, malnourished, pregnant or nursing animals. Avoid contact with humans. For external use only. Avoid getting into eyes or mouth. Irritation may occur after using any pesticide product on pets. If signs of sensitivity occur, bathe your pet with mild soap or a non-antibiotic shampoo and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs continue, consult a veterinarian immediately. Discontinue use if irritation develops. Repeat if needed.

FIRST AID: If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible.

If on skin or clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15 - 20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If in eyes: Hold eye open and flush slowly and gently with water for 15 - 20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If swallowed: Call poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment. You may also contact 1-800-345-4735 for emergency medical treatment information.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

APPLICATION: Pet-Guard Insecticide Gel is an insecticide gel that contains an insect repellent and sunscreen. To apply, simply lift nozzle cap and apply squeezing pressure to bottle for easy flow of product onto palm of hand or desired area, then rub into coat. Pet-Guard Insecticide Gel imparts a high gloss to the coat when rubbed in or brushed out leaving no other visible sign of treatment. It is especially adaptable for treating difficult areas, such as the face or ears and will not blister, remove or discolor hair. Avoid the pet's eyes during application. Do not reapply product for 3 days.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL DIRECTION: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.

STORAGE: Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: If empty: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
