**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling

Rotate nozzle 1/4 turn to spray position and squeeze trigger to initiate a fine mist spray. (Close nozzle after use to avoid loss of product) Spray at a distance of 6 to 12 inches by squeezing trigger repeatedly and rapidly

**FOR DOGS AND CATS**

Direct the spray over the animal until the entire coat is slightly damp. Do not spray directly into face. On a heavily coated animal, ruffle the coat and spray against the lay of the hair. For best results in controlling ticks, spray directly on the tick. Thoroughly spray interior of kennel or other sleeping quarters. Repeat treatment as necessary. Do not spray structural surfaces where spotting, staining, or discoloration may be objectionable.

**FOR KITTENS AND PUPPIES**

Treat same as dogs and cats except for nursing kittens and puppies, wrap the animal in a towel which has been sprayed lightly. Leave the nose and mouth exposed for normal breathing. Keep the animal wrapped for 5 to 10 minutes. Fleas may then be removed from the coat by picking or combing. Repeat as necessary

**FOR HORSES AND PONIES**

To control Stable Flies, Horn Flies, Houseflies, Face Flies, Horse Flies, Deer Flies, Bot Flies, Mosquitoes and Gnats, apply spray directly to horse's coat giving particular attention to legs, shoulders, flanks, neck, and topline. To treat face, dampen a cloth with spray and rub on face and head being careful to avoid eyes. Repeat as necessary.
