c. Add the following precaution

Do not use more than one collar per animal.

d. Delete the term "safety" from the product names "Baccara/Francodex Safety-Stretch Flea Collar." Claims as to the safety of a pesticide product in any form are unacceptable.

e. Add the common name "Diazinon" to the label ingredients statement as follows:

Diazinon [O,O-diethyl O-(2-isopropyl-6-...)]

3. In regard to the product chemistry information submitted, the following comments apply:

a. Change the upper limit for the lower limit and vice versa for polyvinyl chloride for both the basic and the alternate Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF).

b. Provide the correct CAS number and correct color index for the following

Paliatol Yellow K0961 HD

Sicopal Brown K2595

It appears the CAS number stated is incorrect, hence the color index could also be incorrect. Unless this information is provided and approved by the Agency, these two coloring dyes may not be used in either the basic or alternate formulations.

4. Submit 5 copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

**CAUTION:** This collar is intended for use as an insecticide generator and is not to be taken internally by man or animal. Not intended for use on humans. The insecticide in this collar is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Do not allow children to handle or play with this collar. May cause skin sensitization following repeated contact with skin in susceptible individuals. Avoid repeated contact with skin. If sensitization reactions result consult a physician.

Do not use other pesticides on dog while collar is worn. Some dogs and humans may be sensitive to this collar. Remove at first sign of irritation or adverse reaction. Do not use on sick or convalescing dogs.

Note to Physicians/Veterinarians: Diazinon is an organophosphate insecticide. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered, but only in conjunction with atropine.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this collar in a manner inconsistent with its labelling.

Place the Baccara<sup>®</sup> collar around the dog's neck with the colored velvet strip to the outside, buckle and adjust for proper fit. Cut off and dispose of excess length. The collar must be worn loosely so that two fingers may be placed between the collar and dog's neck. If collar is worn too tightly, it may produce neck irritation. This collar is also designed to stretch. It helps the dog to free itself if the collar gets snagged on a fixed object. Activity against fleas starts within 24 hours, reaches maximum effectiveness in 4 days and continues as long as the collar is worn (up to 90 days). Fleas present in the dog's environment that may reappear on your pet will be killed by the action of this collar. Replace collar when effectiveness diminishes. Exposure to wetness or rainfall may decrease the duration of effectiveness of this product.

**DISPOSAL**

Do not reuse empty plastic blister, cardboard backing or collar. Wrap in newspaper and place in trash collection.
