Provide supportive therapy until collar fragments are voided. If dog cannot be roused, Yohimbine, 0.1mg/kg by intravenous injection is antidotal. Repeat as needed.

Place the collar around the dog's neck, adjust for proper fit and buckle in place. Cut off and dispose of excess length. Do not allow dogs to play with cut-off excess. The collar must be worn tightly enough to contact skin and so the dog cannot remove it.

Activity against ticks starts within 24 hours and continues as long as the collar is worn (up to 90 days). Ticks present in the dogs environment that may reappear on the dog will not attach and will be killed in less than 24 hours. Replace collar when effectiveness diminishes. The effectiveness of the collar is not diminished by normal wetting such as rainfall, however, it is suggested that the collar be removed before bathing. This product does not control fleas.
