3. In regard to the product chemistry information submitted June 28, 1991, the following comments apply:

a. Recalculate the upper and lower limits, column 14, for: "plastic matrix," "stabilizer," "filler," and "toxicant;" note that the percent active ingredient for the toxicant, diazinon, does not agree with the label claim.

b. The total percent by weight for column 13 does not add up to 100%.

4. Submit 5 copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

Place Protectiontm 300 collar around the dog's neck, adjust for proper fit and buckle in place. Cut off and dispose of excess length. the collar must be worn loosely so that two fingers can be placed between collar and dog's neck. If collar is worn too tightly, it may produce neck irritation. Activity against fleas starts within 24 hours, reaches maximum effectiveness in 3-4 days and continues as long as the collar is worn (up to 300 days). Rhipicephalus sanguineus ticks are relatively harder to kill and die more slowly. Activity against ticks will occur within a few days. This collar will continue killing and controlling ticks for up to 210 days. Fleas and ticks present in the animal's environment that may reappear on the dog will be killed and controlled by the action of the collar. Replace collar when effectiveness diminishes. Collar is not affected by normal wetting such as rainfall; however, it is suggested the collar be removed before bathing.

DISPOSAL

Do not reuse empty blister. Wrap blister and put in trash collection. When discarding used collar, wrap in newspaper and place in trash collection.
