c. Under the statement of Practical Treatment for the caption "If Inhaled" change the statement to read as follows:

. . . Remove victim to fresh air or if not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth to mouth, get medical attention. . . .

d. Limit use of the product to residential sites only by adding "only" to the front panel i.e.:

. . . For use outdoors on Residential Lawns and Around Residential Premises Only to Kill . . .

e. Under "Directions for Use" add the following statement:

. . . Keep pets and children out of the treated area until the spray has dried. Do not spray on animals.

The following statement is optional. We have no objection if you wish to include it at the end of the above statement.

. . . Dogs, cats, their kennel or bedding area should also be treated with a registered flea and tick control product in conjunction with this application . . .

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 5(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Do not induce vomiting because of aspiration pneumonia hazard.

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Get immediate medical attention.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air or if not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth to mouth, get medical attention.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labelling.

To kill fleas and ticks harboring in lawns, backyards, dog kennels and runs, apply RESIDUCIDE concentrate through a hose end sprayer or by compressed air sprayer or watering can.

For hose end sprayer application, place required amount of RESIDUCIDE concentrate in sprayer jar (see chart below) and fill with water to recommended level. Mix well, attach to sprayer and spray as recommended. For best results, lawn should be mowed a day or two before spraying. Spray using a slow, even sweeping motion, being sure to cover the entire lawn surface where pets frequent. Spray under ornamentals and trees but avoid soaking young or flowering plants.

<u>Amount of RESIDUCIDE</u>	<u>Amount of Water</u>	<u>Area Treated</u>
1 1/3 fluid oz.	3 gallons	500 sq. ft.
2 2/3 fluid oz.	6 gallons	1,000 sq.ft.
5 1/3 fluid oz.	12 gallons	2,000 sq.ft.

NOTE: 1 fluid oz. = 2 Tablespoons = 6 Teaspoons.

For compressed air sprayer or watering can application, mix two (2) fluid ounces of RESIDUCIDE concentrate per one (1) gallon of water and apply at the rate of one (1) gallon of diluted spray per 1000 square feet to surfaces of kennels, exercise runs, patios, on and under porches, crawl spaces and other outdoor areas pets frequent.
