Dear Ms. Arrington,

In accordance with 40 CFR 152.46, Virbac AH, Inc. submits herewith an application for pesticide notification for subject product. This submission allows for labeling changes per PR Notice 2007-4 to the side/back panel of the label. The labeling changes are noted below and clearly marked on the revised product label (see attachment).

"Notification of label change per PR Notice 2007-4. This notification is consistent with the guidance in PR Notice 2007-4 and the requirements of EPA's regulations at 40 CFR §§ 156.10, 156.140, 156.144, 156.146, and 156.156. No other changes have been made to the labeling or the Confidential Statement of Formula for this product. I understand that it is a violation of 18 U.S.C. Sec. 1001 to willfully make any false statement to EPA. I further understand that if the amended label is not consistent with the requirements of 40 CFR §§ 156.10, 156.140, 156.144, 156.146, and 156.156, this product may be in violation of FIFRA and I may be subject to enforcement action and penalties under sections 12 and 14 of FIFRA."

Revisions to side/back panel of the label in the "Storage and Disposal" section:

Added: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed, by storage and disposal.

Added: Pesticide before Storage

Replace "Disposal" statement with the following:

- Pesticide Disposal and Container Handling: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. If Empty: Place in trash or offer for recycling, if available.

- If Partly Filled: Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place any unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain."

This product is in compliance with 40 CFR 156.140(a)(4) as the lot number is adhered to the product. This product is exempt from 40 CFR 156.144 through 156.156 due to the product's residential/household use. Additionally, this product is not a dilutable (liquid or solid) formulation.

## DIRECTION FOR USE

Cleanse ear thoroughly with a low pH ear cleanser, like Epi-Otic. Place sufficient Otomite Plus in each ear to wet external ear canal. Spread product inside ear canal by massaging the ear. Re-treat at least every 7 days, depending on the severity of the condition, but not more frequently than twice a week. If condition does not resolve in two weeks, discontinue treatment and consult a veterinarian. If it is necessary to reuse an ear cleaner, re-treat afterwards with Otomite Plus.
