SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

Cleanse ear thoroughly with an ear cleanser, like EPI-OTIC® Advanced Ear Cleanser, in accordance with the directions for use. Place sufficient OTOMITE PLUS® Ear Miticide in each ear to wet external ear canal, approximately at the rates, for each pound bodyweight, of 1 drop (maximum 15) for dogs and 2 drops (maximum 10) for cats. Spread product inside ear canal by massaging the ear. Re-treat at least every 7 days, depending on the severity of the condition, but not more frequently than twice a week. If condition does not resolve in two [2] weeks, discontinue treatment and consult a veterinarian. If it is necessary to reuse an ear cleaner, re-treat afterwards with OTOMITE PLUS Ear Miticide.
