PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION May be harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Do not treat pregnant animals, or puppies or kittens under 4 weeks of age. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after using.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical treatment if irritation persists. Carbaryl is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine by injection is antidotal.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to aquatic invertebrates. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL DIRECTIONS

STORAGE: Store in closed container in a cool dry area.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

APPLICATION: Shake well before using. Wet the animal thoroughly with warm water. Apply product to the back of the animal and massage well into the skin to obtain a good lathering over the entire body. Do not get in eyes or on scrotum. Allow lather to remain in contact with the skin for at least 10 minutes. Rinse thoroughly. Repeat shampoo as indicated, but not more frequently than once weekly.
