

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Spray over entire haircoat making sure the coat is thoroughly wetted to the skin. Spray against the lay of the hair, ruffling the coat on long-haired dogs. Weight of dog, length of hair, and density of coat will determine amount of spray to be applied to wet the skin (average dose approximately 7.5g/kg). Eight ounces (8 oz.) of product should be sufficient for two applications at a two month interval to an average 30-35 lb. dog.
