The application referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, and a copy of a stamped label is enclosed for your records.

We have evaluated the similarity in formulations between the subject product and EPA Registration Number 2382-124 (Preventic L.A. IGR) and conclude they are substantially similar for acute toxicity purposes. Thus we will permit you to cite the dermal limit test for EPA Registration Number 2382-124 (Tox Category IV) in support of the subject product eliminating the need for precautionary labeling for this route of exposure.

The phase "and out of the reach of children" in the storage and disposal statements is not required. Thus you may delete this addendum.

This 8 o :. bottle should be sufficient for ten applications at one to two week intervals to an average 30-35 lbs. dog. Lighter applications will reduce period of effectiveness and require more frequent treatment. Allow dog to air dry or blow dry. Do not towel dry.
