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DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labelling. Spray over entire haircoat making sure the coat is thoroughly wetted to the skin. Spray against the lay of the hair, ruffling the coat on long-haired pets. Weight of pet, length of hair and density of coat will determine amount of spray to be applied to wet the skin (average dose approximately 7.5 g/kg for dogs and 5.0 g/kg for cats). This 16 oz. bottle should be sufficient for three - four applications to a 30-35 lb. dog or 20 applications to a 10 lb. cat. When applied at the label dose rate, the pet should not be retreated more frequently than once each 14 days. Lighter applications will reduce period of effectiveness, may result in earlier reinfection and may require more frequent retreatment. For best results in controlling ticks, spray directly on the tick. Allow pet to air dry or blow dry. Do not towel dry. This product is formulated to leave the hair coat soft and manageable for grooming.
