

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Spray the animal until the entire coat is wet. On heavily coated animals, ruffle the coat and spray against the lay of the hair to ensure penetration to the skin. For best effects against ticks, ensure that ticks are wetted with the spray. Dosage is approximately 5g/kg on cats, 7.5 g/kg on dogs, depending on density and length of haircoat. This bottle contains sufficient spray for 5 applications to a 25lb dog or 20 applications to a 10 lb. cat. When applied at the label dose rate, the pet should not be retreated more frequently than once each 14 days. Lighter applications will reduce period of effectiveness, may result in earlier reinfection and may require more frequent retreatment. Thoroughly spray interior of kennel or other sleeping quarters. Do not spray structural surfaces where spotting, staining, or discoloration may be objectionable.

**KILLS** - Fleas, ticks and lice.

**STERILIZES** - Pyriproxyfen (Nylar®) IGR sterilizes fleas for up to 30 days and breaks the flea life cycle.

**DEODORIZES** - Imparts a pleasing residual aroma.
