**HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC

HAZARDS TO HUMANS: Avoid breathing spray

haircoat making sure the coat is thoroughly wetted
to the skin. Spray against the lay of the hair,
ruffling the coat on long-haired dogs. Weight of
dog, length of hair and density of coat will determine
amount of spray to be applied to wet the skin
(average dose approximately 7.5 g/kg). This 16
oz. bottle should be sufficient for three applications
at one month intervals to an average 45 lbs. dog.
Lighter applications will reduce period of
effectiveness and require more frequent
treatments. Allow dog to air dry or blow dry. Do
not towel dry.
