2. Make the following label changes:

- a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No. 2382-134".
- b. Delete the statement, "Do not use on pups under 3 months of age." and replace it with the statement, "For use only on adult dogs.". The referenced Domestic Animal Safety Study only supports use on adult dogs.
- c. Add the statement, "To prevent harm to you or your pet, read entire label before use," to the Directions For Use.

- d. Add the wording, "old" and "on animals undergoing drug or other pesticide treatment", to the statement "Consult a veterinarian before treating pregnant, nursing, sick, or debilitated dogs."
- e. In the last sentence under Hazards To Animals change "consult veterinarian if reaction persists" to read "immediately seek veterinary advice".
- f. Under Hazards To Humans change the statements, "May cause eye irritation. Do not get in eyes." to read "Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes or clothing."
- g. The correct spelling for the chemical name for Permethrin is (3-Phenoxyphenyl)methyl(±)cis-trans-3-(2,2-dichloroethenyl)-2,2-dimethylcyclopropanecarboxylate.
- h. In the Confidential Statement Of Formula the correct supplier of the Technical Nyar is Sumitomo Chemical Co., Ltd.
- i. Note that the solvent in the basic formulation is a List 2 inert (potentially toxic inert/high priority for testing). Accordingly you may wish to substitute a less toxic inert for this ingredient.

3. Submit two (2) copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENT

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

HAZARDS TO HUMANS: May cause eye irritation. Do not get in eyes. Avoid breathing spray mist. Use only in a well ventilated area. Avoid contamination of food. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after using.

HAZARDS TO ANIMALS: DO NOT USE ON CATS. Do not use on pups under 3 months of age. Consult a veterinarian before use on pregnant or nursing bitches, or on old, sick or debilitated dogs. Do not spray in eyes, face or on genitalia. Until dry, do not confine treated dog in area without adequate cross ventilation. In the event of adverse reaction, shampoo dog with a non-pesticidal shampoo to remove pesticide residue and consult a veterinarian if reaction persists.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If in Eyes: Flush with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Do not use or store near heat or open flame. STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool area away from heat and open flame.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labelling. Spray over the entire haircoat making sure the coat is thoroughly wetted down to the skin. Spray against the lay of the hair, ruffling the coat on long-haired dogs. Weight of dog, length of hair and density of coat will determine amount of spray to be applied to wet the skin (average dose approximately 1.5-3.0 g/kg). This 16 oz. bottle should be sufficient for 7-14 applications at one to two week intervals to an average 40 - 50 lb. dog. Lighter applications will reduce period of effectiveness and require more frequent treatment. Allow dog to air dry or blow dry. Do not towel dry.
