

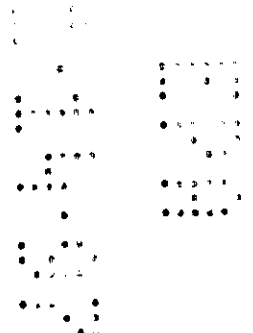

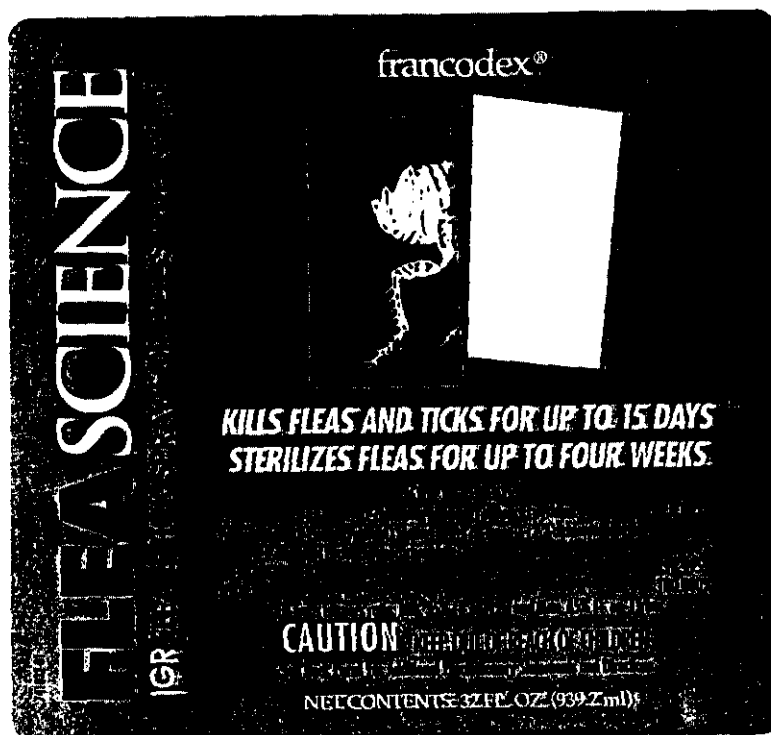

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS**

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals
CAUTION

HAZARDS TO HUMANS: Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes or clothing. Avoid breathing spray mist. Use only in a well ventilated area. Avoid contamination of food.

Wash thoroughly with soap and water after using.

HAZARDS TO ANIMALS: DO NOT USE ON CATS. For use only on adult dogs. If in Eyes: Flush with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

Flammable: Keep away from heat and open flame.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool area away from heat and open flame.

Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. To prevent harm to you and your pet, read entire label before use. Spray over the entire haircoat making sure the coat is thoroughly wetted down to the skin. Spray against the lay of the hair, ruffling the coat on long-haired dogs. Weight of dog, length of hair and density of coat will determine amount of spray to be applied to wet the skin (average dose approximately 1.5 - 3.0 g/kg). This 32 oz. bottle should be sufficient for 14-28 applications at one to two week intervals to an average 40-50 lb. dog. Lighter applications will reduce period of effectiveness and require more frequent treatment. Allow dog to air dry or blow dry. Do not towel dry.
