READ ENTIRE LABEL BEFORE USING USE ONLY ON CATS
PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS CAUTION

HAZARDS TO HUMANS: This collar is intended for use only on pet animals. Do not allow children to handle or play with this collar. Wash hands with soap and water after handling.
HAZARDS TO ANIMALS: Do not use on nursing kittens. Consult a veterinarian before using on debilitated, aged, medicated, pregnant or nursing animals. Sensitivities may occur after using any pesticide product on pets. If signs of sensitivity occur, remove collar and bathe your pet with mild soap or a non-pesticidal shampoo and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs continue, consult a veterinarian immediately.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this collar in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Place collar around the cat's neck, adjust for proper fit and buckle in place. Cut off and dispose of excess length. The collar must be worn tightly enough to contact skin. If collar is worn too tightly, it may produce neck irritation.

This collar is designed for long term prevention and control of flea problems by preventing the build up of flea populations through its adult flea and flea egg sterilizing actions. Ideally, as a preventive measure and for maximum effect, this collar should be applied to the cat before the flea season starts. Its flea sterilizing activity, that sterilizes fleas already on the cat, starts immediately, reaches 100% effectiveness within 2 days and continues at 100% effectiveness as long as the collar is worn (at least for 370 days). Fleas already present in the cat's environment, that may reappear on the cat, will be immediately sterilized before they start to lay eggs so that only sterile dead eggs will be laid. The potential for development of new fleas in the cat's environment, that would normally reinfest the cat, will thus be prevented for a full year. It is recommended therefore that this collar should be replaced once a year, perhaps on a significant date such as the pet's birthday or on the first of January.

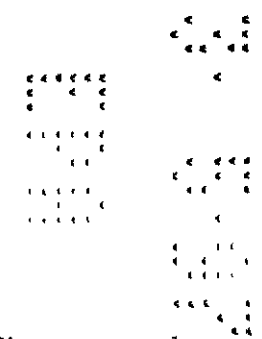
The active ingredient in this collar, Nylar®, is not an insecticide or acaricide, is not toxic and will not kill adult parasites. Therefore, if the cat or its environment is heavily infested with fleas when the collar is first applied, the collar's flea and flea egg sterilizing benefit will not be apparent for several weeks until all pre-existing environmental flea life cycle stages have developed and either found a host or died. In these circumstances it is necessary to use other means (e.g., insecticide treatments, applied to both the pet and its environment) to kill existing flea stages on the pet and in its environment. Tick infestation must always be controlled by products labelled for ticks. The collar and its active ingredient in the cat's haircoat are not affected by normal washing or by bathing. Replace collar as needed.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty pouch or box. Wrap pouch or box and put in trash collection. When discarding cut-off excess collar or used collar, wrap in newspaper and place in trash collection.
