- d. Split the precautionary statements into two sections: Hazards To Humans and Hazards To Animals. Under Hazards To Humans, add the statement, "Wash with soap and water after handling.". Under Hazards To Animals, add the statements, "Do not apply to nursing kittens. Some animals may be sensitive to ingredients in this product. Observe pet for possible signs of adverse reactions. If animal has adverse effects, remove collar and immediately seek veterinary advise.".
 - e. Have your supplier of Bayferrox 180M and Flash Black 19976 submit their chemical compositions including chemical names, Cas numbers, and percentages of each component. Manufacturing Safety Data Sheets should also be submitted.

Submit two (2) copies of the revised final printed label before you release the product for shipment.

If the final printed labeling is not received prior to shipment of this product, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these requirements.

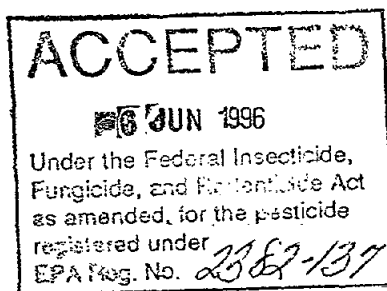

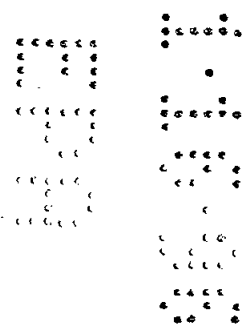

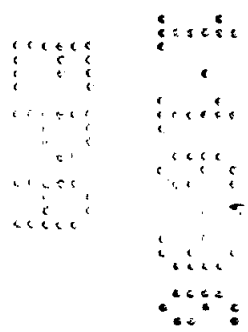

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: This collar is intended for use only on pet animals. Do not allow children to handle or play with this collar.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this collar in a manner inconsistent with its labelling. Place OVISTERILANT COLLAR #2 collar around the cat's neck, adjust for proper fit and buckle in place. Cut off and dispose of excess length. The collar must be worn tightly enough to contact skin. If collar is worn too tightly, it may produce neck irritation.

This collar is designed for long term prevention and control of flea problems by preventing the build up of flea populations through its flea sterilizing action. Ideally, as a preventive measure and for maximum effect, it should be applied to the cat before the flea season starts. Its ovicidal activity, that sterilizes fleas already on the cat, starts within 24 hours, reaches 100% effectiveness in 2 days and remains 100% effective as long as the collar is worn (up to 300 days). Fleas present in the cat's environment that may reappear on the cat will be sterilized before egg laying commences. The potential for development of new fleas in the cat's environment that would reinfest the cat will thus be prevented.

The active ingredient in this collar is not an insecticide or acaricide, is not toxic and will not kill fleas or ticks. Therefore, if the cat or its environment is heavily infested with fleas when the collar is first applied, the collar's ovisterilant benefit will not be apparent for several weeks until all pre-existing environmental flea life cycle stages have developed and either found a host or died. In these circumstances it is necessary to use other means (e.g., insecticide treatments, applied to both the pet and its environment) to kill existing flea stages on the pet and in its environment. Tick infestation must always be controlled by products labelled for ticks. The collar and its active ingredient in the cat's haircoat are not affected by normal wetting or by bathing. Replace collar as needed.

DISPOSAL

Do not reuse empty pouch or box. Wrap pouch or box and put in trash collection. When discarding used collar, wrap in newspaper and place in trash collection.
