other areas where flea and tick infestation is observed. Part hair to
contact skin and ensure good coverage. Hold sprayer about one foot
away from animal during application. Apply until skin and hair are
thoroughly moist. Do not retreat pet more frequently than once every
two weeks.

TO REDUCE INFESTATION OF ANIMAL: Thoroughly spray the
animal's bedding and other resting areas. Spray entire inside
surface of dog houses. Repeat as often as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool area away from heat and open flame.
DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap in several layers
of newspaper and discard in trash.
