making sure the coat is thoroughly wetted down to the
skin. Spray against the lay of the hair, ruffling the coat
on long-haired dogs. Weight of dog, length of hair and
density of coat will determine amount of spray to be
applied to wet the skin (average dose approximately 1.5
-3.0g/kg). This 16 oz. bottle should be sufficient for 7-
14 applications at one to two week intervals to an
average 40 - 50 lb. dog. Allow dog to air dry or blow
dry. Do not towel dry. When product is applied at the
full recommended rate, pet should not be retreated for
14 days. Lighter applications will reduce period of
effectiveness and require more frequent treatment.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool area.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap in
several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
