**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** It is a violation of Federal law to use this  
product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Spray over entire  
hair coat making sure the coat is thoroughly wetted to the skin. Spray  
again at the lay of the hair, ruffling the coat on long-haired pets.

Weight of pet, length of hair and density of coat will determine amount  
of spray to be applied to wet the skin (average dose approximately 7.5  
g/kg). This 16 oz. bottle should be sufficient for three - four  
applications to a 30-35 lb. dog. For best results in controlling ticks,  
spray directly on the tick. Allow pet to air dry or blow dry. Do not  
towel dry. This product is formulated to leave the hair coat soft and  
manageable for grooming. Allow dog to air dry or blow dry. Do  
not towel dry. When product is applied at the full  
recommended rate, pet should not be retreated for 14  
days. Lighter applications will reduce period of effectiveness and  
require more frequent treatments.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

**STORAGE:** Store in a cool area away from heat and open flame.  
**DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Wrap in several layers  
of newspaper and discard in trash.
