**HAZARDS TO HUMANS:** Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes or clothing. Avoid breathing spray mist. Use only in a well ventilated area. Avoid contamination of food. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Wash exposed skin with soap and water after using.

### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If in Eyes: Flush with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

### PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Flammable: Keep away from heat and open flame.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labelling. To prevent harm to you and your pet, read entire label before use. Spray over the entire hair coat making sure the coat is thoroughly wetted down to the skin. Spray against the lay of the hair, ruffling the coat on long-haired dogs. Weight of dog, length of hair and density of coat will determine amount of spray to be applied to wet the skin (average dose approximately 1.5 -3.0g/kg). This 16 oz. bottle should be sufficient for 7-14 applications at four to six week intervals to an average 40-50 lb. dog. Allow dog to air dry or blow dry. Do not towel dry. When product is applied at the full recommended rate, pet should not be retreated for 14 days. Lighter applications will reduce period of effectiveness and require more frequent treatments.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**STORAGE:** Store in a cool area away from heat and open flame.  
**DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Wrap in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
